

NOTE: If you have a security freeze and/or fraud alert on your credit report with Equifax you must first remove the freeze or alert prior to applying for Medicare.

You can then re-freeze or add the alert back on once Medicare has accepted your application.

Sign up for Medicare f you're 65 or older, you can enroll online for Parts A and B, or Part A only You can delay Part B if you're already covered through an employer group

I understand that I am entering a U.S. Government System to file a benefit application with the Social Security Administration. I understand that I need to provide the Social Security Administration information to process the benefit application. I understand that failing to agree to the statements below will result in my inability to file a benefit application online, which may prevent the Social Security Administration from making an accurate and timely decision about eligibility for benefits.

I understand that

- · the Social Security Administration will validate the information I provide against the information in Social Security Administration's system
- my activities may be monitored within this site
- any person who knowingly and willfully tries to obtain Social Security benefits falsely could be punished by a fine or imprisonment, or both.
- · I am authorized to file a claim on my own behalf or on behalf of someone else with the Social Security Administration.

Save your user ID and Password somewhere safe, you will receive an email code for verification. Confirm your email address and use confirmation code to log in.

Once you are logged in - Fill in all Info requested:

- ** Select NO to Medicare PART B
- ** SELECT: That you ARE STILL covered by Group coverage
- Have your employment dates available when completing the application.
- KEEP THE RE-ENTRY number available until you receive your Medicare ID card...
- **Review** the info you entered and digitally sign the form by typing your name.

FINIAL CONFIRMATION:

You should receive a letter from the SSA in about 2 weeks. If they need any additional information, they will ask for it in that letter. If not, you should expect your Medicare card to arrive in about 2-4 weeks.

You should be able to find your Medicare number on your "My SS account" within 15-30 business days.
